- 1. Roll call: All Trustees except Jo Ann Vear were present.
- 2. Minutes: Trustee Lucas moved and Trustee George seconded to approve the minutes of March 10, 2021. Motion unanimously approved.
- 3. Public comment: Trustee Tanner announced the letter of resignation of the Vice Chair trustee Vear. The trustees agreed on extending warmest thanks to Vear during her time as a Vice Chair and as a Trustee of the Pajaro Valley Public Cemetery District.
